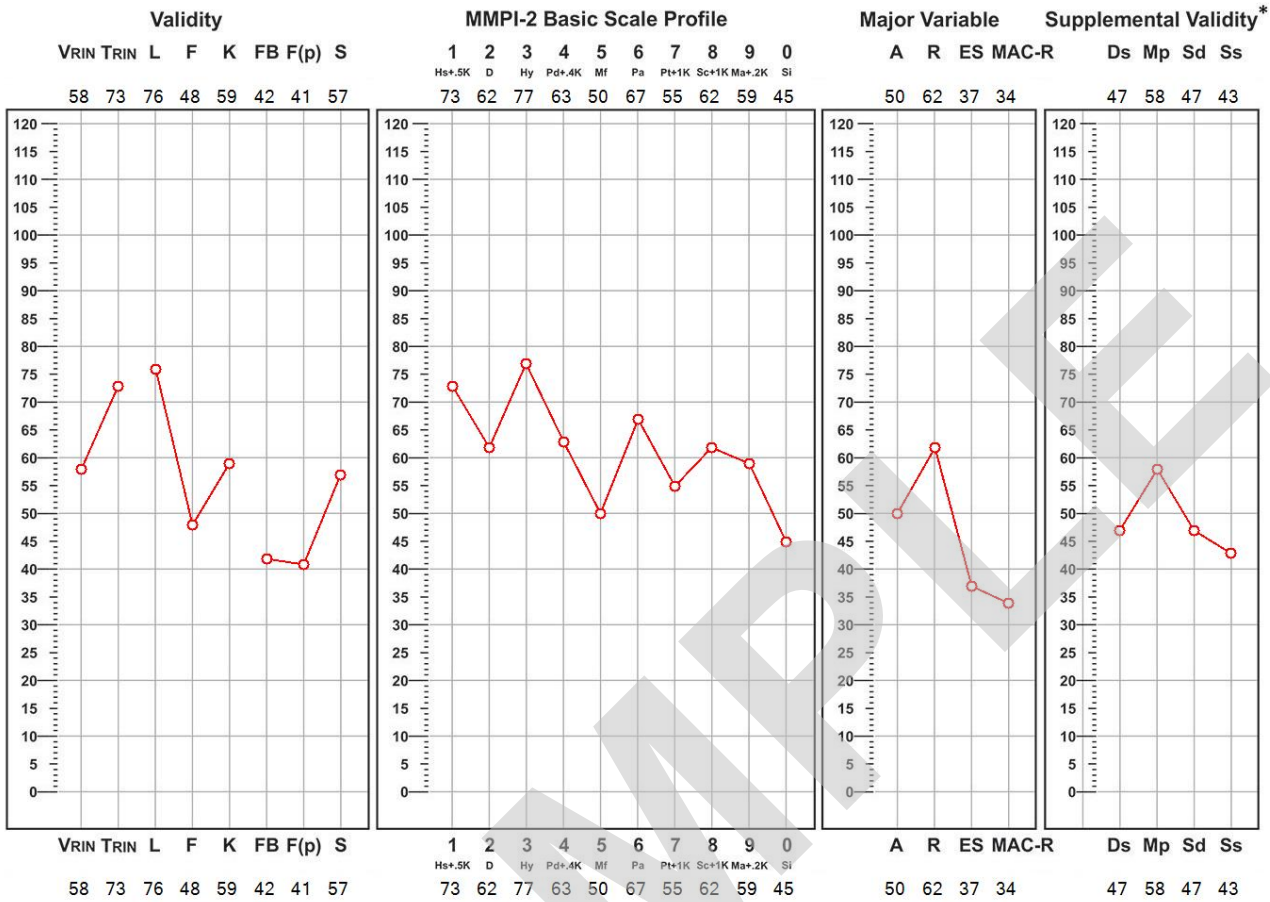
Attention and Comprehension: Her score on the Variable Response Inconsistency scale (VRIN) was mildly elevated but within the normal range. This indicates that she was able to read and comprehend most if not all of the test items, that she was rarely if at any time inattentive in considering her responses, and that she adequately matched the item numbers in the booklet to the corresponding numbers on the answer sheet. She does not appear to have had any serious difficulties in understanding the content or in responding to the format of the inventory. In contrast to her lack of substantial elevation on VRIN, she obtained a more elevated score in the false direction on the True Response Inconsistency scale (TRIN). This indicates that she responded "false" to both items in a well above average number of pairs of items that contradicted each other, perhaps reflecting a "when in doubt say false" attitude.

Attitude and Approach: She was very guarded, denying, and self-favorable in her approach to the inventory. The clinical scale elevations she obtained may be suppressed and incomplete and the pattern somewhat distorted. Considering just scales L, F, and K, the interpretive statements are probably accurate, but they may understate the severity of her problems and her level of disturbance.

She made almost no atypical and rarely given responses to the items in the second half of the inventory (scale F-back). This was consistent with the relative absence of such rare answers to the earlier MMPI-2 items (scale F). The profile clearly does not appear to be of questionable validity because of atypical responding.

Socio-cultural Influences vs. Conscious Distortion: The supplemental validity scales showed an average to below average score on the scale (Ss) measuring her level of currently attained, recently experienced, or self-perceived socioeconomic status. She did not show any significant amount of conscious defensiveness. It appears that her elevation on scale K was due to such factors as emotional reserve and sophistication; it was not due to any intentionally self-favorable slanting of her responses. In fact, her K score was unexpectedly high for her Ss score; that is, this level of socioeconomic status identification is usually associated with a lower level of sophistication on K. Her elevation on scale L appears to reflect elements of a moralistic properness with strict personal controls. There may be an "unconscious blocking out" of threatening perceptions or inputs that she needs to avoid or cannot manage or even a subtle degree of "concreteness" in her thinking. She may be seen as a bit naive. Her elevation on L does not appear to be due to conscious test deception or intentional "faking good".
